<p><u>Individual Liberty and Mutual Respect</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We choose which book we wish to read from the bookshelf or library • We choose between packed lunch and school dinners • We choose which playground we would like to play in at 1.00 • We choose which game we would like to play at lunch time • Y6 can pick their own pencil case • On Mufti day we can choose our own clothes • We don't talk under an adult while they are talking • We don't answer back • We work quietly so as not to disturb others • Enrichment own choice of activity • Variety of meal options at lunch time including Halal and Vegetarian • We choose which clubs we would like to attend • We can earn 4c tokens • We can choose to write in pen or pencil 	<p><u>Tolerance of those with different faiths and beliefs</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We don't make fun of other beliefs or if someone wears a hijab (headscarf) • In assembly we bow our heads to show respect when we pray just as we would in a mosque, synagogue or church • We don't mock others because of their faith; we allow children of different faiths to attend our school • We are not rude to other children or adults in our school • If an adult needs to pray at lunch time or before school we have quiet rooms in which they can pray • We celebrate different religious celebrations (Diwali, Chinese New Year, Eid Holy Week) in different ways • Visit to Westminster Abbey Y6 Oct 2015 • Visit to Hindu Temple Y5 Nov 2015 • Y4 visit to a Catholic Church Jan 2016 • International Food Festival Oct 2015 • Assemblies on Mondays cover different faith celebrations • Christian Values puzzle pieces • We have a multi faith parent sewing group
