Dear St Cuthbert parents,

I hope that this letter finds you and your family well.

In the light of the government announcement on Monday 22 February about return to schools for all pupils, I am writing with updates from St Cuthbert's!

We will be 'reversing' out of this lockdown fairly similarly to the way we entered.

We have been given advice to have systems of prevention in place:

- A risk assessment available on our website
- Keeping pupils in class bubbles where possible
- Staggered entry and exit times
- Avoidance of whole school events
- Providing before and after school provision for pupils of families where parents need to attend work
- Taking active steps to reduce general mixing of children in before and after school care
- Ensuring enhanced cleaning, robust hand sanitizing, robust ventilation, social distancing where possible
- Ensuring strict adherance by St Cuthbert school community to government advice -including isolating and engagement with NHS testing
- Limiting of general access to site by parents and visitors. Parents to wear face masks at our school gate
- Pupils remaining at home if they develop symtoms of a high temerature, ongoing cough, loss of taste or smell, extreme muscle ache, diarrhoea or vomiting

These systems were all in place before we locked down in January, so we will be reverting to these routines from **March 8<sup>th</sup> until end of spring term**. We will update parents at this point.

This spring term, we have had to increase prices of breakfast club, play centre and school dinners. Updated prices will be available on SIMS PAY from 5<sup>th</sup> March.

Staggered entry and exit times will be as in autumn term, as identified in the grid
