You can overrun into maths time as you have no maths worksheet today)</p>	<p><b>9:30 – 10:30 English</b></p> <p><b>Unit 3 day 2</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Children choose Philemon or Baucis (or one of the unfriendly neighbours for a much harder challenge).</li> <li>They think about how the story would change if told from that point of view. What would they not know? (Jupiter and Mercury’s exchange on Mount Olympus.) What might have happened before the visitors that day? Children should use clues presented in the story setting (e.g. <i>they may have fed the goose, watered the cabbage</i> etc.).</li> </ul> <p>Children draw a new story map to tell the story of the transformation of their home, focusing on point of view and including details added through prediction and inference, e.g. thoughts and feelings of the point of view character.</p>	<p><b>9:30 – 10:30 English</b></p> <p><b>World book day</b></p> <p>Talk through comics and some examples Talk about favourite comics and why</p> <p><b>Start World Book day tasks ☺</b></p>	<p><b>9:30 – 10:30 English</b></p> <p><b>Unit 3 day 3</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Children work individually to write a letter to a cousin, retelling the myth from the point of view of Philemon or Baucis.</li> <li>Children to include details such as feelings, hopes and comments.</li> </ul> <p>Children can include some dialogue (punctuated) in their letter, but limit this to one or two interesting examples.</p>
