RED ALERT WEATHER CONDITIONS

With a Red Alert for weather on Monday 18th July and Tuesday 19th July, I am writing to update parents on routines for our pupils.

School will remain open for teaching and learning with routines in place to ensure the safety of our pupils. Please see the **Risk Assessment** on this page for Red Alert weather conditions.

If parents feel that they would prefer to keep their child/children at home on Monday 18th and Tuesday 19th July due to the Red Alert for London's weather, please can you inform our school office via the absence line or via email to info@scwsm.rbkc.sch.uk.

As detailed in the **Risk Assessment**, children will wear summer uniform (dresses/ shorts. shirts). Children will not wear school ties. Alternatively, if children feel cooler in their PE kits these may be worn. Children will wear peak caps or sunhats.

Please put protective factor sun cream on your child before they attend school.

Please send your child to school with a water bottle. Children will be reminded to drink plenty of water through the day.

Children will eat lunch in our air conditioned dinner hall.

We will be adjusting our day so that no physical PE or outdoor activity takes place after 11am. Alternate PE lessons and play activities will be taking place in shade or indoors.

At the end of the day, pupils will be dismissed from under the awning in the KS2 playground to ensure that they are not waiting in the heat.

There are no clubs next week.
