Year 6's Blog

Welcome to our astonishing blog!!

In English, we have been learning about different styles of poetry. We were looking at some poems by the poet named Benjamin Zephaniah. We were looking at two of his most famous poems; called 'No Problem' and 'I Love My Mother'. We also compared and found the features of these two

poems and explained why and which poem we enjoyed/didn't like the most in groups. In my group - Lillymae, Giya, Sarah, Mohammed, and Ana - we liked the poem called 'I Love My Mother' because it was very heart-touching and it shows how much the poet loves his mother.

In Maths, we have been learning and recapping how to add, subtract, and multiply mixed and improper fractions. An example of adding fractions is Stated in the following: $\frac{3}{5} + \frac{5}{5} = 1 \frac{3}{5}$. We also were learning how to write a fraction number sentence for example $5 \frac{3}{4} - 1 \frac{3}{8} = \frac{23}{4} - \frac{11}{8} = \frac{46}{8} - \frac{11}{8} = \frac{35}{8} = 4 \frac{3}{8}$. We have also been doing fraction reasoning sheets which are related to adding, subtracting, and multiplying fractions.

In RE (Religious Education), we have been learning about a religion called Buddhism. In this topic, we have been learning about their beliefs and the eightfold path. The eightfold path is the teachings of the Buddha that can lead to the end of suffering. The eightfold path includes being kind, having a good intention, having a good mindset, and mindfulness, right effort, the correct livelihood, the right speech, and correct actions. We have also been learning about the Buddha's origin and life. The Buddha was born in a place called Lumbini in Nepal. The Buddha also reached enlightenment after meditating for 49 days under the Bodhi tree and realising that all suffering comes from being greedy and always wanting more. After this, he spread around and told people the truth of why everyone was suffering. Even after he died, lots of people passed down this story from many generations ago to this day.

In DT (Design Technology), we have been learning about the topic called textiles and how they can become more sustainable. We have also been learning about fast fashion and how we can stop fast fashion/reuse reduce and recycle. Fast fashion is clothing brands that do not make very sustainable and long-lasting clothes. Normally fast fashion brands last for a few weeks or months. Some examples of Fast fashion brands are Shein, Primark, Vinted, Temu, H&M, Pretty Little Thing, Bershka, and M&S. PSHE (Personal, Social, Health, Economic), we have been learning about kindness and sympathy. We had a lady come in named Miss Alexis and she taught us about kindness how to be kind and how to affect others by kindness. *By Giya and Sarah*

Year 4's Blog

Welcome to the amazing Year four blog!

In English, we are learning about fairy tales. First, we made a mind map, and then we watched and read the Three Little Pigs story! Next, our teacher gave us a sheet of paper and we had to guess what the fairy tales were. POV: H and G means Hansel and Gretel. We also wrote about our Christmas holidays and how we spent it. Some went on a trip to another country and others stayed in London and went to Winter wonder land.

In Maths we are learning division and multiplication. We looked at multiples of 10 and factors of 10. We also solved word problems.

In Science, we have been learning about states of matter. We compared and sorted groups of materials together according to whether they were solids, liquids, and gases. We then wrote facts about the matter, e.g. a gas is something we cannot see, a solid is a hard material, and a liquid moves around quickly.

In DT we are learning about mechanisms. We looked at how to make pop-up books. We explored how it might work and labelled each part, such as lever, pivot, joint, hinge, pop-up, and slide mechanism. The types of movements are linear and rotary and used vocabulary like design, mock-up, plan, and fit for purpose. Then we drew our first draft and labelled the parts. *By Ayo and Sarah*

MATHS

In Maths, we have been learning about equivalent fractions. We learnt different methods to find if the fraction is equivalent.

To turn unit fractions into equivalent fractions time the numerator and the denominator by any number. Unit fractions are fractions where the numerator is 1.

DT

SCIENCE


