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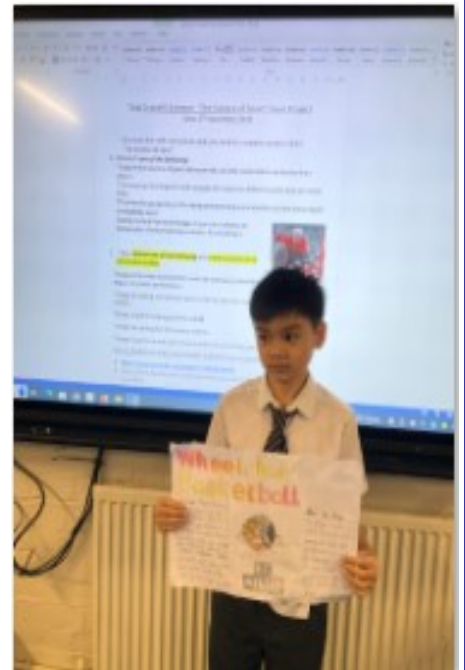
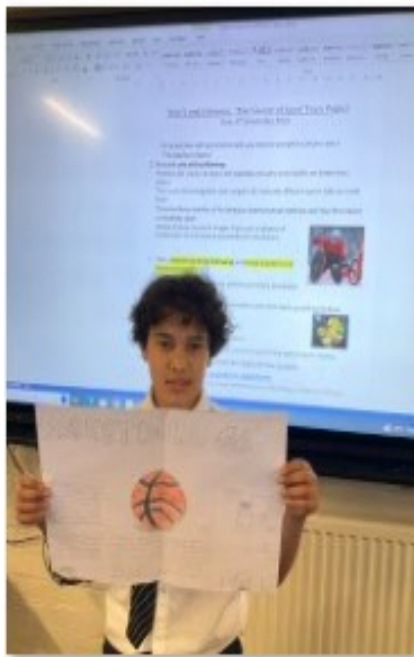
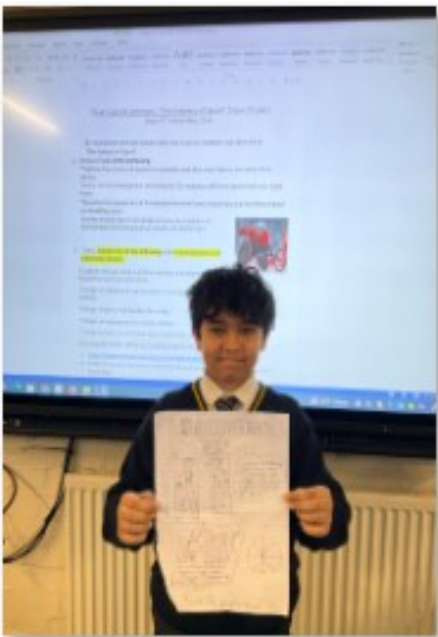
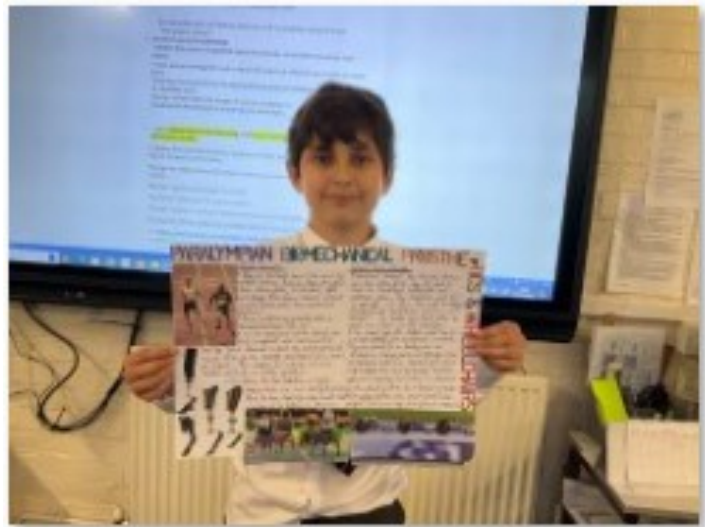
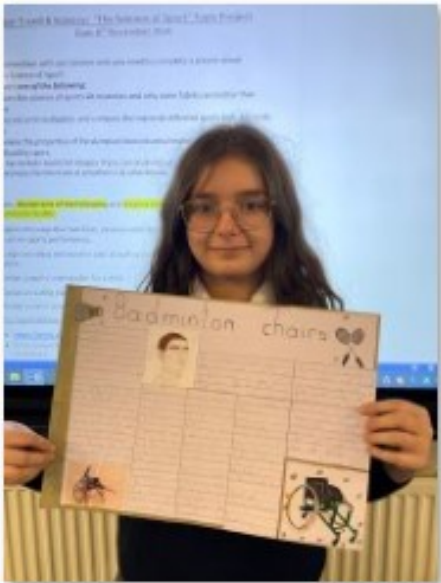
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Year 3 and 4 created home learning around their topic, "Ancient Greece".





Year 5 and 6 created projects around their learning on "The Science of Sport". They then presented these to their class!

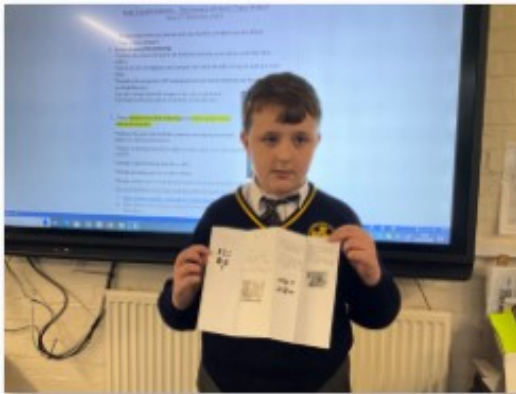
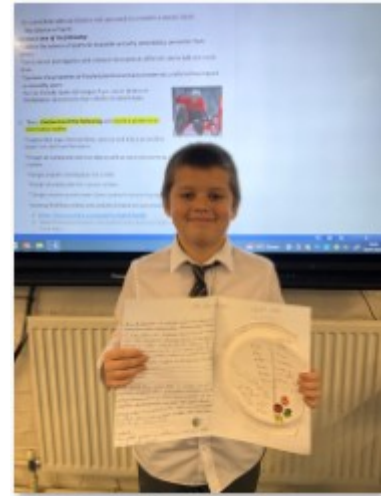
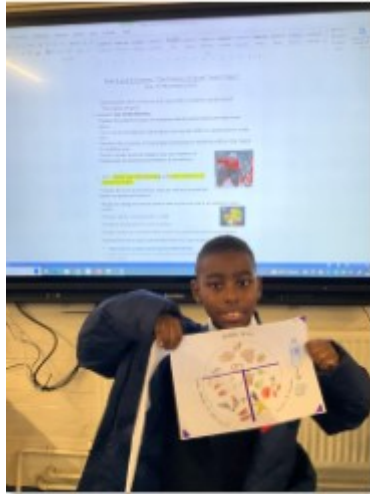
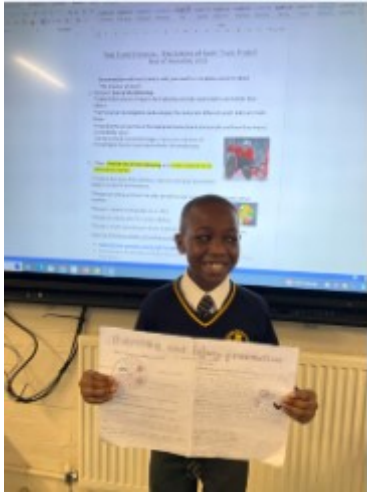
